HIDDEN PICTURES

The children of 3 and 4 years old in my child care have been enjoying looking for hidden pictures on drawings. You can buy activity books with hidden pictures in bookstores but you can also them print them out from the internet. One good website that I use is www.allkidsnetwork.com. Go to the website and click Kids Activity and then Hidden Pictures. You don't have to download any pictures. Just click on a picture you like and print it out. I usually give my children easy ones first before they move on to complicated ones. The Allkidsnetwork website also has many craft ideas for young children.

KINETIC SAND

Judy Labrin, our member, introduced me to a fun, dynamic, activity-based material called *Kinetic Sand*. You can order it from Quality Classroom. It is \$42.95 for 11 lbs of kinetic sand plus 10% shipping charge (Winter Green sells it at \$59.95 plus 15% shipping charge). Judy suggests that I get at least 11 pounds of sand. She uses 3 bags of 11 bounds in her childcare and the children play with it nonstop. Judy generously welcomed anyone interested in seeing how sand works to visit her childcare.
